The Kingdom of God – God's reign of peace, justice and love- on earth because of Jesus and will be perfect at Judgement Day

mustard seed – parable that shows even the tiniest thing can make a big difference

vocation – what you are CALLED to do , not just your 'job'

Father Damien – saint from Hawaii who was unafraid to help lepers and shows us we must help even if we are scared

priesthood– vocation of service to the church and its community

Holy Orders – vows taken when called to the priesthood- sacrament of service

Matrimony – vows taken when called to family life with a husband or wife- sacrament of service- unbreakable covenant!

the good Samaritan – parable that shows we must help others- even if that person is an enemy

Pope John Paul II – challenged young people to use technology to be good examples for others and be the 'moral force'

the rich young man – parable that tells us that to enter the kingdom of God, we must sell all that we own and give it to those who need it more- this is why it is hard for the wealthy to be Christian!

Peter the Apostle- was trusted by God to keep the keys of the kingdom- is an example of friendship even though he 'messed up' – is the rock of our church

Beatitudes- Jesus' teachings about how to live and find real happiness in God's Kingdom

St. Elizabeth of Hungary – gave her life serving those who were sick, poor and outcast

consecrate – to set aside for a sacred purpose- to bless

parable – stories Jesus told that taught lessons to those who listened

grace- God's life within us, a gift that God freely gives us

Pharises – Jewish people who strictly lived the written laws of the Old Testament and Jewish Tradition-
Jewish faith leaders

Abba – the word that Jesus used to teach people to call God 'Father' in prayer

sanctification- the act of making something holy

berahot – short prayers said throughout the day-

penance – another name for the Sacrament of Reconciliation

discipleship – following Christ by carrying on Christ's mission

injustice- mistreatment of people so they cannot have what they need or what they should have

Lord's Prayer- Jesus taught us how to pray to God in his Sermon on the Mount

petition- prayer where we ask God for something

Catholic Campaign for Human Development- established in 1970 to break the cycle of poverty in the US-
helps improve the lives of those in need

Human Dignity- the right of every person to feel important and valuable
