Sorrowful Mysteries

- 1. The Agony in the Garden-
- In the Garden of Gethsemane with the 11 Apostles (Judas has betrayed Jesus)
- Jesus takes Peter, James and John further in the garden and asks them to watch as he prays- Jesus is very sad about what is going to happen to him next- but they fall asleep 3 times
- Judas shows up with soldiers, gives Jesus a kiss to identifying him. Jesus is taken by the soldiers.
- 2. The Scourging at the Pillar-
- Pontius Pilot does not think Jesus is guilty- he interviews him to try to get Jesus to say he is not guilty
- Pilot offers to free a prisoner, Jesus or the murderer, Barabas- the Jewish people choose Barabas
- Jesus is stripped and tied to a pillar and whipped until he bleeds
- a mob surrounds Jesus yelling as the Roman soldiers whip him
- 3. The Crowing with Thorns-
- After whipping him, the Roman soldiers made fun of Jesus by putting a red robe on him (the color of royalty)
- They pressed a mock crown made of thorns onto his head
- They shouted 'Hail, King of the Jews,' as blood from the crown of thorns blinded Jesus
- 4. The Carrying of the Cross-
- Jesus was forced to carry his cross for crucifixion to Calvary
- Mary walked with him
- Jesus fell many times- a many from the crowd, Simon, was told to help him carry the cross
- Veronica, a follower of Jesus, wiped his face with a cloth
- At Calvary, the Roman soldiers prepared Jesus to be crucified
- 5. The Crucifixion The Resurrection:
- The soldiers nailed Jesus to the cross and placed a sign saying 'The King of the Jews'
- Jesus was hung between two thieves- one ridiculed Jesus, the other defended him

- Many people came by to mock Jesus as the was dying on the cross
 At 3 o'clock, Jesus cried out to God and he finally died on the cross-there was an earthquake

6. The Resurrection:

8. The Coming of the Holy Spirit:

- After Jesus Ascended, he told the Apostles to go to Jerusalem and wait for him there
- They were gathered in a room, praying
- a mighty wind blew and tongues of fire appeared over their heads
- This is the 'birthday' of our church- the Apostles went out and began preaching the Good News of Jesus to everyone

9. The Assumption of Mary

- Mary lived many more years, but she grew old and she died
- Jesus took her BODY AND SOUL up to Heaven
- She remains there today to help those who ask her

9. The Coronation of Mary-

- In Heaven, Mary was crowned Queen
- Jesus is a King, so his mother must be a Queen
- Mary always obeyed God and was humble before him so she deserves this honor
